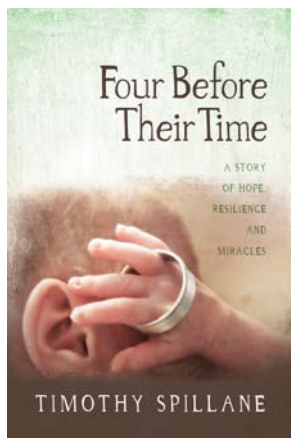

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UPDATE: International Neonatal Consortium

In early March Deb Discenza attended the 2nd International Neonatal Consortium at the FDA.

With neonatal drugs often being a minimized dosing of adult medications, not enough research has been done to 1) check the effectiveness of these medicines and 2) to consider new therapies specifically for this field.

The International Neonatal Consortium recently convened at the FDA to take steps to rectify this across the areas of Retinopathy of Prematurity (ROP), Infections and Necrotizing Enterocolitis (NEC), hemodynamics (conditions relating to blood pressure), seizures and Bronchopulmonary Dysplasia (BPD).
