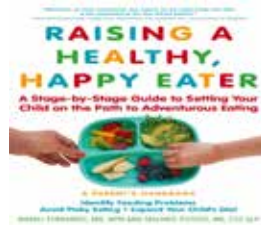


Book: *Raising a Healthy, Happy Eater*

Sadly, we live in a society where an infant or toddler tethered to medical equipment or seeming different physically or behaviorally in any fashion invites people with no sense of decency to ask inappropriate questions.

Preemies, unfortunately tend to fall prey to these unbelievably rude questions and comments: "She's so small!" or "What's wrong with him?" or "Does she have disabilities?" or "Is he going to be normal?"

Your answer? A look of silent surprise and then just stare at the person. If they don't get the message, then walk away without saying a word. *They don't deserve a response.*
